MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING

July 30, 2024

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors was held on July 30, 2024, at the Headquarters' Office in Macon, MO. The meeting convened at 4:00 p.m. and was called to order by President Jay Collins.

A motion was made and seconded to approve a board resolution allowing Macon Electric Cooperative to borrow \$5,000,000 from the National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Cooperation (CFC) in the form of a PowerVision loan. This loan will allow Macon Electric to draw funds as needed over a five-year period. Resolution attached.
